A rain-swept Birmingham Country Club course Friday couldn't cool off the consistent roll of Mary Agnes Wall as she defeated Margaret Russell of Oakland Hills, 7 and 5, for the Michigan women's amateur title.

As they went into the final 36 holes of the tournament, both had their sights on the title that they had won before.

Miss Wall, the Menominee star, had taken the crown in 1948 and 1949 and Miss Russell won the title in 1938.

Both women shot rounds of 41-40 in morning play although Miss Wall needed a 15-foot putt for an eagle three on the 17th green to keep even with her opponent.

Miss Russell had trouble with her tee shots in the afternoon round and fell six strokes short of Miss Wall's 38. Up to this round both women stayed with the pace evenly.
