In another recently released film, "Pearless Fagets", the young actor plays opposite Keenan Wynn.

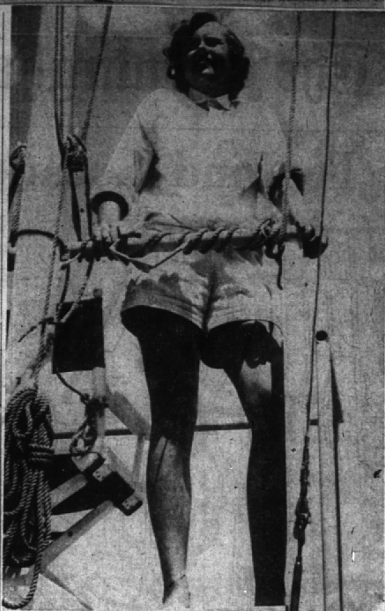
Jim plans to return to Birmingham for the September 6 wedding of his sister, Sue. He will be accompanied by his roommate, Carl Milletaire.
