Local Area Phone Rates Are Boosted

The increase in telephone rates granted the Michigan Bell Telephone Company last week by the Michigan Public Service Commission will amount to less than two cents per day for residence users in this area.

The monthly increase in rates for one-party local service in Big Beaver, Mayfair, and Southfield is 25 cents. Subscribers to local service two-party lines will pay an increase of 50 cents in those exchanges.

The only residence service affected in Birmingham is two-party local service, which is increased 25 cents a month. There is no charge in residence extended-area service in any of the above exchanges.

Oakland Hospital Is Rotary Topic
E. A. Tomlinson, president of the Oakland hospital, told members of the Birmingham Rotary club of the new hospital, now being worked on, at their luncheon meeting Monday.

Tomlinson said the 200-bed, \$4,200,000 building would be in the working-drawing stage within a week or 10 days, with the ground breaking scheduled for late this fall.

Spoking for the first time before any representative group in Birmingham, Tomlinson said it would be two years before the project would be completed.

He told them that, although the Greater Detroit Hospital Fund campaign had officially ended, monies were still being received and were being proportioned among the participating hospitals.

Bloomfield Takes Second In Golf Finals At Midland
The Bloomfield Hills high school varsity golf team placed second in the state class C-D golf finals held at Midland Country Club recently.

Ten teams competed in the event that saw Bloomfield in its best year's competition. In the final, Bloomfield lost first place by one stroke.

Roof Fire Damages Bloomfield Home
Sparks from an inside incinerator ignited roofing materials discovered the fire and warned Mrs. Averill who was talking on the telephone at the time. The roofers brought their ladders to the home and began fighting the blaze with garden hoses.

Two Bloomfield Village trucks and one from the township department responded and quickly controlled the fire. Averill, assistant village fire chief, was summoned in time to help the firemen. The damage was covered by insurance.
