CAST: The Wage Earner (HE)
His Life Partner (SHE)
A Dean Coffin, Inc. Salesman
TIME: An evening, early this summer
PLACE: A screened-in porch

AT THE RISE OF THE CURTAIN, THE WAGE EARNER IS SCROUNGED ON THE PORCH GLIDER, READING A MAGAZINE. HIS LITTLE BIRD ENTERS.
HE (LAUGHS UPROARIOUSLY)
