## Church to Dedicate Building to Youth

With the dedication of the new youth building of the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer Sunday afternoon, the 10th anniversary of the dedication of the church building will also be observed.

The dedication service is to be held at 4 p.m., with the Rev. Erwin Kurth, pastor of St. Mark's Lutheran church, Detroit, making the dedicatory address. The program will be under the direction of the Rev. Theodore Wuggazer, Redeemer pastor.

More than 300 children can be accommodated in the new building in a variety of activities. In addition to a large assembly room there are individual classrooms, a nursery, Scout activities room and caretaker's apartment. A youth room, equipped with a fireplace and kitchenette as well as the pastor's and secretary's offices are also housed in the building.

A LARGE portion of the basement remains unfinished. This will provide additional space to meet future demands. The overall project includes driveways, parking area, sidewalks and the landscaping of the grounds. Drives are designed to permit separate entrances and exits to the grounds for church and Sunday school traffic.

The youth building, designed by Earl Confer and built by the George W. Auch company, both of Detroit, will represent a total cost of about \$170,000. The need for the new building is pointed out in a review of the ten years of the church itself. At its dedication the congregation numbered 130 with 50 children enrolled in the Sunday school. Today the church has 600 communicants with 380 children in the church school. The dedication of the youth
