**Three Proposals In Southfield Special Election**

Three proposals will be submitted to Southfield township voters at the August 5 primary elections. The special election will concern a pension plan for the fire department, a civil service commission to cover fire department employees and a hunting ban for a period of two years.

Southfield firemen have been active in publicizing both the proposed pension plan and civil service system.

Township board members have expressed their fear of the costs of the combined program, but agree that some consideration should be given the firemen.

The no hunting law would give the township the right to arrest any persons guilty of hunting in the township with firearms. This proposal was approved for the ballot by township members Tuesday night.

**TWELVE VOTING** precincts have been set up in Southfield.

Precinct numbers: one—Brooks school, Eleven Mile and Lahser; number two—John Grace school, Indian avenue; number three—Lathrup school, Southfield road; number four—McKinley school, Ten Mile and Southfield; number five—Franklin Community hall; number six—Brace school, Evergreen and Midway.

Precinct seven—fire hall, Thirteen Mile road; eight—Southfield high school, Lahser at Ten Mile road; nine—fire hall, Nine Mile and Prosper; ten—Southfield school, Ten Mile and Berg; eleven—East Southfield school, Pierce road; twelve—Magnolia school, Dorset.

**Zoning Fee Added To Building Permit In Southfield**

Southfield township board members Tuesday night added a zoning fee to accompany building

permits on new construction.

Board members, pinched by decreasing revenues from the state and the increase in demand for services from residents, decided on the fee to keep alive the workings of the township planning commission. Township officials have been worried about the source of the \$1,500 allotted to the planning group in the coming

facial budget.

The rate for the zoning fees will be one dollar for construction valued from \$101 to \$500; \$2 from \$501 to \$1,000; \$3 from \$1,001 to \$15,000; \$5 from \$15,001 to \$100,000; and \$10 for any permit larger than \$100,000.

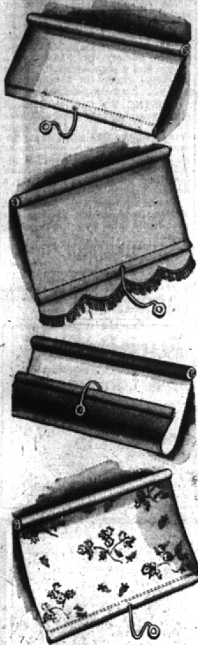

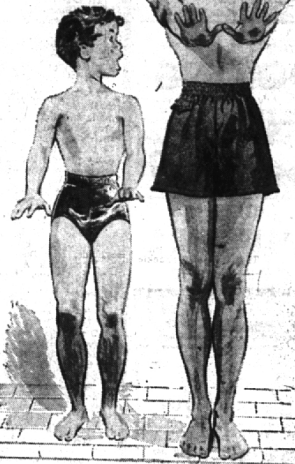
