

No Action Taken On Troy Licenses

Discussion but no action was taken on a letter from the Michigan Liquor Control Commission by Troy Township board members Monday night indicating that the township could have three additional class C liquor licenses based on present population figures. Eleven applicants have submitted requests for licenses to the commission. The township now has four licenses. The matter was referred to the township liquor committee for study.

Franklin village voters may register at the Franklin village town hall from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday July 1. It was announced this week.

Water Contract Awarded Walker

A contract for engineering services on a 12-inch water main to run on Berg road from Nine Mile road to Ten Mile road was awarded to Sam Walker, Birmingham, Tuesday night by the Southfield township board. Cost of the engineering will be \$1,500. Walker's flat fee was below bids of other firms who asked for 5 per cent of the total construction costs. Cost of the project has been estimated at \$40,000.

Reese Appointed to Recreation Board

Rollie Reese, 1847 Webster, has been appointed by Mayor Dean G. Beier to the Recreation Board for a five-year term. Reese fills the vacancy left by Harold Gasser who resigned last week.

Southfield Seeks More Information On Water Auth.

Preliminary discussion on Southfield township's stake in the recently proposed Southeastern Oakland County water authority found township members interested in the project but fearful of the costs. Board members expressed their

desire to learn more about the ultimate cost of the Greenfield water main out of Detroit to Southfield and the methods of financing preliminary engineering services and the bond issue. 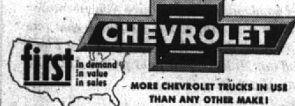
