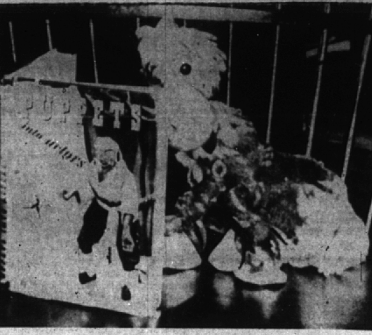
Annual Family Fete For Monnett Club
