City Pigeonholes Plans for Pool

The city commission Monday night decided to pigeonhole all plans for a municipal outdoor swimming pool unless public sentiment reverses the proposition.

Mrs. Anne Garrison, former president of the Birmingham Community Council, wrote a letter to the commission stating that the council had voted that no outdoor pool should be planned at the present time.

Commissioner Frank Rising, head of the city's committee, commented that he was surprised at the council's move and wondered just how much power the council had in determining action on city projects.

RISING ADDED that last fall he had addressed the council on plans for the pool and handed out detailed reports to all members present. There were no questions at this time and the commission heard no further from the council until January when they learned the council had turned down the proposal.

Commissioner Ralph Main said that the community organizations that he belongs to were not polled on their sentiments by the council

and doubted whether all other organizations had had their say on the matter.

Mrs. Ruth Shain explained to commissioners that the council was a rather sketchy organization and had no power to decide on city issues.

"It is purely an advisory group," Mrs. Shain commented.

Commissioners agreed to let the plan drop but added that they would like to see a list of the organizations polled and the results of their balloting.

Trees Are Gone—But Fight Is Not

The cutting down of the trees on W. Maple came up before the city commission, again, Monday night, and commissioners assured residents that they valued every highly Birmingham tree and would not have removed them if the street widening had not warranted it.

Mrs. Charles Shain questioned the city's actions without letting the people know the whole story about the Maple improvement. She pointed out that Maple has become a "sun-baked street that will be a speedway near a school where little children attend."

Mrs. Shain explained to Mrs. Shain, "We had five public hearings on the Maple construction just so that people would not charge us with the same thing you are charging us with now."

Beier and City Manager Donald C. Egbert failed to recall any objections to the plan at the time of the hearing.

Egbert answered the speedway question by saying that the city is doing everything to channel the bulk of east-west traffic onto Fourteen Mile and Sixteen Mile roads.

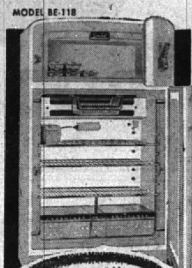
Asphaltic Resurfacing Assessment Roll Created

A \$15,033 special assessment will be levied in one payment against property owners for the asphaltic concrete resurfacing of Hawthorne from Maple to Linden, Aspen from Maple to Hawthorne and Linden from Maple to the south half of lot 18, Birmingham Park allotment.

The estimated cost for the entire project is \$20,000, and it is planned to get the work done this summer.

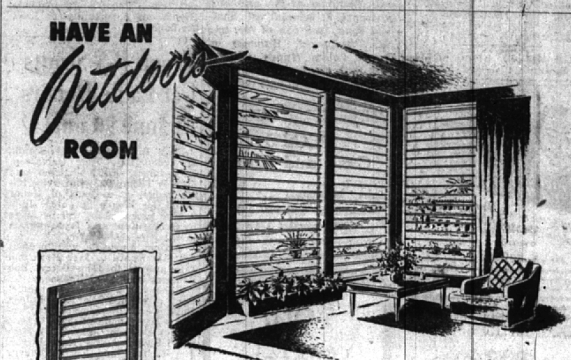

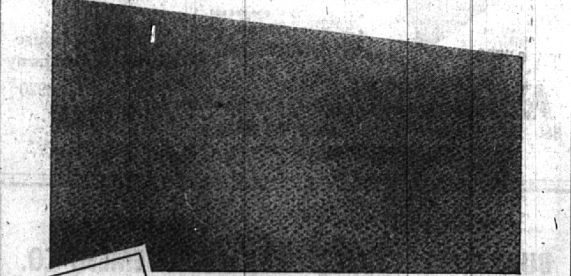
