Woodward General funds turned over to Oakland Hospital Board

Assets Transferred To Oakland Hospital

Consolidating hospital interests in South Oakland County in the projected new Oakland Hospital to be erected at Woodward Avenue and 13 Mile Road, trustees of Woodward General Hospital have effected the transfer of more than \$200,000 in assets to Oakland Hospital.

In a transaction at the Birmingham National Bank Friday, officials of both Woodward General and Oakland Hospital signed and accepted deeds and other documents turning over funds previously raised for Woodward General Hospital which included \$534,000 cash and government securities, more than \$200,000 in mortgages and 105 acres of land at the Woodward-13 Mile road site valued at \$100,000.

H. LLOYD CLAWSON, chairman of the Woodward General Hospital group, turned over to Franklin Fricker, vice president of Oakland Hospital, the bonds and cash and also signed the deed to

the land and other documents legally transferring the South Oakland Hospital assets to Oakland Hospital.

To be added to South Oakland's contribution is \$3,500,000 from the Greater Detroit Hospital Fund, \$100,000 from the original proposed Bloomfield Medical Center, and \$650,000 to be privately subscribed for the clinic in the new hospital, providing \$5,100,000 financing for the project which is scheduled for construction next year and completion by July 1954.

A final fund drive for \$200,000 to complete the Greater Detroit Hospital Fund's \$19,720,000 campaign will be launched Friday in Oakland County. The Greater Detroit fund's solicitation in this area was delayed pending consolidation of hospital aims and determination of a construction site.

*MERRITT D. HILL, vice president of Dearborn Motors, is chairman of Oakland Hospital's campaign committee which will conduct a fund raising program among industries and key individual donors in the populous South Oakland County area.

According to Hill, with the announcement of consolidation of interests behind Oakland Hospital a number of large unpaid pledges to Woodward General Hospital have been paid in and two substantial contributions to the new \$200,000 campaign already have been made.

Hill announced that campaign organization meetings will be held this week with solicitation commencing Friday. The campaign will conclude April 4.

Three Division Chairmen Named for Fund Drive

Appointment of three division chairmen to direct the \$200,000 campaign which will complete the financing of the new Oakland Hospital has been announced by Merritt D. Hill, vice-president of Dearborn Motors, general chairman.

The campaign in the Royal Oak-Ferdale area will be conducted under the leadership of H. Lloyd Clawson, rector, 2135 Northwood, Royal Oak, president of the South Oakland Hospital authority. Assisting Clawson as vice-chairman will be Arthur F. Bassett, Royal Oak, vice-president of Detroit Trust Co.

Royal Oak; Arthur Lee, Consumers Power Co., Royal Oak; and Sherman LeMessure, DeVing Machine Co., Ferndale.

The division chairmen are completing their campaign organizations in preparation for solicitation which will start Friday and continue through April 4.

and some individuals, who have previously contributed to the Greater Detroit Hospital fund. The Greater Detroit Hospital fund campaign in 1949 to 1951 fell slightly short of its goal of \$19,720,000. At that time, no solicitation for the fund was conducted in Oakland County pending a decision on the location and other details of the proposed hospital.

Success of the present campaign in South Oakland County would enable the Greater Detroit Hospital Fund to make full allocation of funds to approved hospital projects.

IN THE BIRMINGHAM area, the drive will be directed by J. Thomas Smith, Martel Drive, Bloomfield Hills, president of Detroit Harvester Co. He will be assisted by co-chairmen, Herbert H. Gardner, president of the Birmingham National Bank, and Mrs. Peter B. Loomis, 1648 Dorchester.

The industrial campaign throughout South Oakland County will be headed by F. Earle Steele, 916 Madison, vice-president, Ferndale National Bank. Serving as co-chairman of the industrial campaign organization will be Lucien Lamoureux, Pompanau Metal Products Co., Ferndale; Harold Lesch, Wayne Oakland Bank.

REALIZATION of the campaign goal will complete financing of the \$5,100,000 Oakland Hospital which is being erected on the 105-acre site at Woodward and 13 Mile Road. The four-story, cross-shaped building will provide complete facilities for 200 bed patients plus an ambulatory clinic and complete emergency service.

Under the banner, "Let's Finish the Hospital," the campaign unites various groups which have endeavored for several years to make long-needed additional hospital facilities available in this area. Volunteer workers will contact 1,000 selected prospects in the area, business and industrial firms
