

Local 'Y' Teams Take Wins From Fisher Cagers

Both the Birmingham YMCA men's varsity and the junior boys' teams won basketball victories over Fisher 'Y' last week. The Junior Boys took their sixth win against the losses and capped their third consecutive game as they won 48-14.

Birmingham was away to a slow start and garnered only one basket in the first three minutes. Jack Fowler and Tom Masters hit on lay-up shots to give the Dark Green a 12 to 2 first quarter advantage.

Sam Stinson ran wild in the second quarter to funnel in 18 points and put the locals out in front 32 to 4 at half-time.

With both Bob Gasser and Sam Stinson on the bench in the second half, the Birmingham reserves took over and lengthened the scoring lead to 42 to 6. Tom Stinson played an outstanding game for the locals.

BIRMINGHAM 'Y' VARSITY came up with a good second half to win over the Fisher Men's team 64 to 39. The locals had trouble finding the basket during the first 15 minutes and were behind 15-6 at the quarter.

In the second period, Earl Mudge, Bob Folin, and Don Little began to click and netted 12 points between them to close the game.

It was Fisher's game at half-time 22 to 18 as both teams left the floor for a hectic 20 minutes of play.

In the second half, Birmingham demonstrated its stretch drive and won going away. Earl Mudge with 18 points topped both teams in scoring.

Birmingham closes its regular season Thursday against Northern at Highland Park. The Jumbos defeated the Highland Parkers by one point in their last meeting on a last minute basket by Don Little.

The game is at 8:45 p.m. on the Barrum Junior High school floor and is open to the public.

Sylvan Lake Man To Seek Office As Prosecutor

Chief Assistant Oakland County Prosecuting Attorney Frederick C. Ziem announced today he will seek the prosecutor's office on the Republican ticket in the September primary.

Ziem's announcement is the first made by any candidate for county office. He will run for the position now held by Prosecuting Attorney Clyde D. Underwood.

Ziem said Underwood would not be a candidate for reelection. Born in Detroit on Mar. 17, 1916, Ziem has been a resident of Oakland county for 30 years.

He was educated in Pontiac schools and was graduated from the University of Michigan law school in 1941.

Ziem is married and has one son, Frederick C. Jr. He lives at 2172 Garland avenue, Sylvan Lake.

WITH HIS announcement, Ziem said "It has long been my ambition to serve the people of Oakland county as prosecuting attorney. I have spent two years preparing myself for the position, for I feel a candidate for any public office should become qualified before seeking that office."

"I have served as an assistant prosecuting attorney since January 1, 1947 and as chief assistant prosecutor since June, 1950 to January 1947 I was engaged in the private practice of law in this county and served with the Judge Advocate General's department during World War II."

"As a result of this training, in which I have participated in the trial of almost every type of criminal case, I feel I have the experience, ability and temperament essential to carrying out the duties of this important office. I also feel that I am thoroughly familiar with all the problems facing a prosecutor in Oakland county."

Slight Change in Proposed Finance Amendment Made

To conform to provisions of the Home Rule Act, a slight change has been made in the proposed city finance department amendment which will be submitted to local voters at the April 7 election.

City Attorney Forbes S. Hascall told the commission Monday that the governor hasn't approved the proposed amendment because the Home Rule act stipulates that a city charter should provide for a system of accounts which shall conform to "such uniform system as may be required by law."

Objection is that the amendment lacks the form of accounting up to the Director of Finance. The new wording states, "the accounting system shall conform to such uniform system as may be required by law."
