Birmingham Commissioner Frank Rising was very impressed with the gathering.

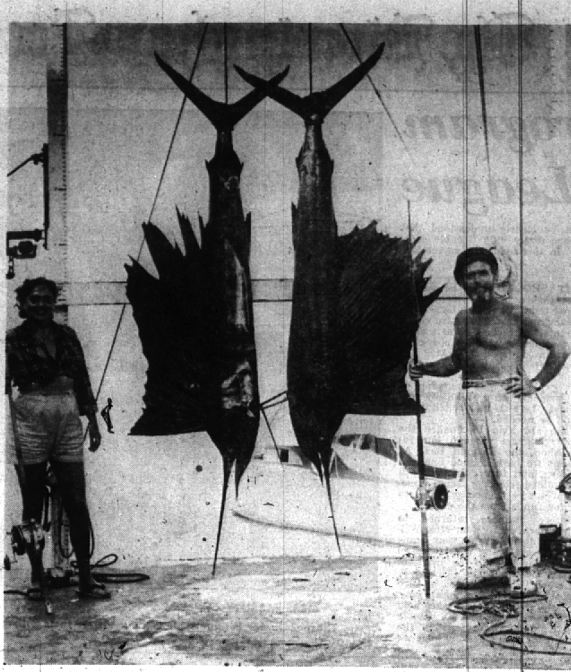

**Plans Announced For Southfield Recreation Program**

Plans for a summer recreation program in Southfield township have been announced by Bob Hall, director of recreation for Southfield schools. Activities will include swimming, hard and soft ball, indoor games, square and social dancing, archery and a library program. Cooperating in this plan is the Southfield Optimist club. A campaign to raise \$6,000 to light a playground is planned by the club in conjunction with other local groups.

**Southfield Twp. School Board Sells Bond Issue**

Southfield School board's \$550,000 bond issue was sold last week Wednesday to H. V. Kelley and Co., Inc. and Associates at an interest rate of 2.9686%. Superintendent Glenn Schoenhals stated that the syndicate's bid was the lowest of three submitted. A total of 21 companies were involved in bidding. Gross interest which the school system will pay for the bonds will be \$22,306.25.

THE SALE will finance a high school and elementary building addition program which township electors approved last December. At the Monday, March 10 board meeting, bids will be taken for construction of an 11-room addition to the high school and one room to Magnolia elementary school. Schoenhals stated that bid taking for the proposed high school gymnasium - auditorium will be postponed until the government approves allocation for structural steel.
