The Birmingham plan board wants more information on the activities of the South Oakland County Planning Commission before recommending the payment of \$500 to that group by the Birmingham city commission.

The board argued over the merits of the SOC commission when conferring with the contribution last week Wednesday night.

Chairman Harry Denyes, Jr., commented that he questioned the existence of the group when Oakland County already is being served by the county planning commission.

"In effect we are multiplying planning commissions. We have commissions advising commissions," Denyes stated.

Chesterfield Parking Lot Answer Ahead

The city plan board tabled action on a proposed 140-foot long parking lot at the rear of the store development at Maple and Chesterfield until the owner of the property, Myron E. Snyder, is able to get resident reaction to the plan from people living in the subdivision.

Snyder submitted to the board an architect's sketch of the proposed lot which would accommodate some 60 cars, relieving the congested angular parking in front of the stores.

The lot would face Chesterfield and would be fenced on the west side, with a hedge on the north and east sides and screen planting on the south bordering the alley at the rear of the stores.

The plan board explained that Snyder would have to first secure a release from the subdivision restrictions before receiving a rezoning of the property from residential to business parking.
