

Judge Turns Down Re-hearing on Merrill By-Pass

The city suffered another setback Monday in its attempts to extend Merrill street through Baldwin park when County Circuit Judge H. Russell Holland turned down an application made by the city for a rehearing on the granting of a permanent injunction forbidding the construction. City Attorney Forbes S. Hancock said late Monday that he will call for the formal filing of the

decrees, then decide whether to take an appeal to the state supreme court.

JUDGE HOLLAND early last month granted the injunction (sought by adjoining property owners) on the basis that any by-pass through the park at Southfield and Maple would be a diversion from park purposes and contrary to the original intent of the donor of the property, Miss Martha Baldwin.

Haskell previously has indicated that any appeal the city would take would be based on the contention that adjoining property owners have no rights greater than the general rights of the public.

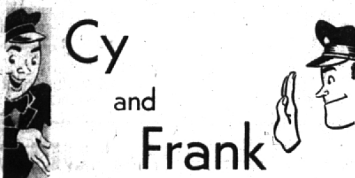
