Bloomfield Twp. May Dump Rubbish In Old Gravel Pit

Residents of Bloomfield township have been given permission to dump rubbish in an abandoned gravel pit on the property of Floyd Beardsley, East Long Lake road.

Beardsley's act is to aid township officials in their present drive to eliminate garbage and rubbish being dumped along streets and highways. It was pointed out that the township had no official dumping place and that access to one might help curb the practice.

A. A. Clark, chairman of the cleanup committee, met with several township supervisors from the area Saturday afternoon to discuss further means of stopping this.

CLARK SAID that due to the number of open roads in the township, with houses widely spaced, the area seems to be a natural target for this. Signs will be posted along these roads in the near future, reminding motorists that they face arrest and punishment when apprehended on these charges.

"For the most part," he said, "it is out-of-town residents who are guilty. They select our area because of its openness and give no consideration for us or our property.

"We are deeply appreciative of the gesture of Floyd Beardsley to allow us to dump rubbish in the old gravel pit, and feel that this will eliminate some of our trouble. Only legal action against other offenders will solve the problem, as far as we can see."



Play IT Safe!

In cooperation with the Birmingham Fire Department, this week The Birmingham Eccentric inaugurates the feature, "Play It Safe", which will be a continuing series containing valuable tips on the various phases of fire prevention. These suggestions, if followed, will help to maintain Birmingham's excellent low fire loss record.

In the City of Birmingham in the last four years, there have been three fires of serious proportions started in homes as a result of improper installation of television antennas.

These television antennas were struck by lightning and because of the absence of proper grounding precautions, the lightning followed the aerial cable into the home and set these fires.

This is the start of the season for heavy electrical storms, and people without proper grounding on the antennas should consider the necessity of this extra protection for their own safety.

BRIEFLY the proper method of grounding is to extend with a tight connection from the antenna mast or frame, a No. 6 or 8 copper stranded wire, a.w.g. (American Wire Gauge). Run this wire down the outside of the building to a 3/4-inch galvanized pipe, flattened on one end, and driven into the earth to a depth of six feet. Connect this No. 6 or 8 wire to this galvanized pipe by a tight clamp designed for the purpose.

If you don't have the time, discuss the matter with a competent electrician or television installer, to effect this type of installation.
