Maples Rout Bears As Mutch Stars

With a tremendous show of running power, the Birmingham football team downed the Berkeley Bears 26-6 Friday night at the Berkeley community field.

Let by Capt. Gordon Mutch in one of his finest performances, the Maples were out in front all the way.

Birmingham marched the opening kickoff 60 yards to score, with signal caller Bob Appleford alternating the ball carrying chores between Mutch and fullback Bill Donaldson, who went over from the three. Mutch added the extra point.

LATE IN THE second quarter after a sustained drive of 64 yards, the Maples racked up their second touchdown when Mutch went 13 yards off-tackle but missed the extra point.

The Bears gained only three yards in the third period, while the Maples continued to score as the halfback John Monaghan capped a 33 yard march by plunging over the line from the two. Mutch added the extra point, and the Maples had a 20-0 lead.

Berkley's only tally came in the final period when guard Jerry Kesser broke through the Maples' forward wall and blocked Mutch's punt on his 19 yard line. Kesser recovered and raced into the end zone for the score. Dick Krainer's conversion attempt failed.

The Maples added their final score in the last quarter when

Monaghan scored his second touchdown of the game on a four yard run. Mutch missed the conversion. The Maples have one remaining game, the annual Thanksgiving day classic with Royal Oak. The game will be played at Pierce field, starting at 10:30 a.m.
