ORDINANCE NUMBER 433
CITY OF BIRMINGHAM
FIRE PREVENTION
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE
NUMBER 145
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 145 OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, KNOWN AS THE FIRE PREVENTION SECTION 1067 OF CHAPTER X, AND ADDING TO CHAPTER X A SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 1011.
The City of Birmingham Ordinance No. 145, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1007, Burning Rubbish
No person shall kindle or maintain any fire or shall knowingly furnish the material for such fire, or shall authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained within the fire district of the City of Birmingham, as established by Section 1012 of this Ordinance. No one shall be kindled or maintained anywhere within the city limits which, in the opinion of the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention creates a hazard to the surrounding property.

The Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention may permit the construction and use of an outdoor incinerator in the Fire District area, when in his opinion, the use of such incinerator will not create a hazard to the surrounding property.

Outdoor incinerators, when authorized for use in the Fire District of the City of Birmingham shall be constructed as follows:

(a) To be constructed of cement block, brick or equivalent approved non-combustible material, laid on a concrete slab with proper footings.

(b) Chimney or metal smokestacks shall be constructed as required by the Building Code of the City of Birmingham. Masonry chimneys shall extend above the roof and not less than four feet above the roof ridge. Metal chimneys shall extend to a height of ten (10) feet. Metal smokestacks shall extend to a height of not less than four (4) feet above the roof ridge. The bottom of the chimney or smokestack shall terminate at least six (6) inches above the top of the flue doors.

(c) Chimney or metal smokestacks to be provided with a spark arrester having a maximum of 1/2 inch mesh, either on (d) Interior of the roof shall be lined with fire brick, cast iron or other suitable fire resistant material. (e) Chimney to be constructed of not less than 12 inch black steel pipe, cemented in during construction, ends exposed, and open. Pipes to be laid on an angle of approximately one (1) inch for every one (1) foot of run. Slope of pipe to be from roof to front.

(f) Bonnet shall be either oval or flat (thick) steel, a minimum of 1/2 inch in thickness or equivalent material. Incinerator shall be constructed in a workmanlike manner.

Maintenance on disposal of residue and upkeep of incinerator proper shall be maintained at all times.

(g) The location of said incinerator shall be with approval of the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention.

That Chapter X of said Ordinance No. 145, be amended by adding thereto a section to be known as Section 1011 which shall read as follows:

Section 1011. Fire
For the purpose of reducing the fire hazard due to the creation of certain types of building construction and storage of flammable liquids, gases or materials within the City of Birmingham, a district known as the Fire District is hereby established. The Fire District shall include the following described territory:

All that property included in "Business A District" and "Business B District" classifications of Ordinance No. 221, as amended, being the zoning Ordinance.

All that property included in "Industrial District" classification of Ordinance No. 221, as amended, being the zoning Ordinance.

All that property especially designated from time to time by regulations of the Chief of the Fire Department to be included in the Fire District.

Said regulations and changes thereof shall become effective upon approval by the City Manager and by resolution of the City Commission, and after publication thereof.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication following the passage thereof.

Made and passed by the Commission of the City of Birmingham this 10th day of November, A.D. 1952.
