

Notify Property Owner On Re-Zoning Hearing

Owner of the property at the southeast corner of East Maple and Adams is being advised of an informal hearing Nov. 10 on his request for re-zoning of the property from single family to multiple family. Should he desire a formal hearing, he was asked to file his request on or before that date.

At an informal hearing by Birmingham city planners in September, it was agreed that this property should remain zoned for single family.

The board pointed out that since it is located in one of the city's heavy traffic areas, it feels residential density should be kept as low as possible.

Board Protests Shopping Center

In a formal resolution Tuesday night, the Birmingham Board of Education endorsed a letter written to the Bloomfield township Board by School Board President Ernest Seahorn opposing the proposed shopping center at Cranbrook and Lincoln. (See letter on Page 5, Part 3).

School Superintendent Doctor Dwight B. Ireland reported that many letters had been received from residents who voiced their protests against the commercial development planned by the Cranbrook Development company.

Ireland read the letters of David S. Farnie, 2439 Fairway; Richard J. Morgan, 930 Larches; William F. McClellan, 21440 Fourteen Mile; and the Northlawn Heights Association.

The board also agreed that some representative of the school district should be present at the township's public hearing of the center.

Oakland Co. Organizes Medical Research Group

A meeting will be held Friday at 8 p.m. in the CIO Hall, 90 Mt. Clemons, Pontiac, for the formation of an Oakland county chapter to promote scientific research on muscular dystrophy.

To date, no cure is known for this disease which has struck some 65,000 American children. Research is going on at the Cornell university hospital at Ithaca, N. Y., which will be furthered through the formation of such chapters.

Additional Funds Passed For Poppleton Pk. Work

Birmingham city commissioners have voted an additional appropriation of \$400 for the completion of one baseball diamond and the erection of a fence at Poppleton park.

A balance of \$150 remains in the initial appropriation of \$5,000, with a major portion of the grading and seeding already completed.
