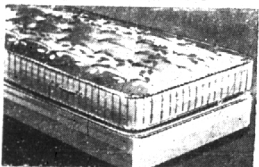

### Traffic Mishaps Down Last Month

Traffic mishaps in Birmingham dropped from 25 in July to 19 in August, according to the monthly report of Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley. A total of 21 violations were listed as compared to 27 in July and 23 in August, 1951.

Four persons were injured in three accidents and property damages for the month were set at \$5,100. Moxley listed contributory factors to these accidents as follows: too closely, eight; failure to yield right-of-way, four; improper parking, disregarding stop sign or signals and improper starting from a parked position, two each; failure to signal, improper passing and driving under the influence of liquor, one each.

### Ordered to Pay City Charge for Filling of Lot

Even though it may cost considerably more, the city commission has ordered the owner of a vacant lot on Southlawn to pay the \$153.40 the city spent in filling and grading it.

E. W. Kurth last week protested that a private individual would only charge \$25 for the same service. But after looking at the cost sheets presented by the DPW commissioners said they couldn't challenge their own cost figures. The lot was filled in last May because it often was filled with considerable water, and had several holes, thus constituting a public nuisance, the city contended.
