

**Wants Systematic  
Paving of City's  
Older Streets**

In the opinion of City Commissioner V. B. Watkins, nothing much seems to be doing to remedy the city's old streets with permanent pavement.

"Most of our recent efforts seem to have been putting in pavements on new streets where there has been considerable new home construction," he remarked to fellow commissioners Monday night.

He said he favored a definite yearly paving schedule for these older city streets, and indicated that "the city commission may have to initiate a paving program that will be unpopular when it is first launched."

**Special Bus Service to U of M Games**

To serve the numerous football fans in Birmingham and nearby communities, Greyhound will inaugurate a special non-stop, Saturday bus schedule beginning Sept. 27, between the Birmingham terminal and the University of Michigan stadium at Ann Arbor.

All seats are reserved. The bus will travel via West Maple, Telegraph Road and Willow Run Ex-

pressway. Departure from Birmingham is scheduled at 12:00 noon to arrive at the U of M Stadium approximately 20 minutes before game time. The football special will return to Birmingham non-stop immediately following the game.

IN ANNOUNCING the service, J. V. Murphy, vice president and traffic manager of the company

and a Birmingham resident, said Greyhound had been studying the feasibility of providing this special service since last fall because of the interest shown by many football fans who wish to avoid driving in traffic, and parking problems at the stadium.

The operation of non-stop service, he added, makes it possible for couples and small groups to attend the games in a group and

enjoy many of the advantages that are available through Greyhound's charter bus service. If it proves popular among Oakland County's football fans, additional schedules may be eventually added, Murphy said.

SEAT RESERVATIONS and purchase of round-trip fare must be made by 9:30 a.m. Saturday, before the game, so the company can assign and route equipment to serve that schedule. The round-trip fare is reported to be \$3.00 plus federal tax.
