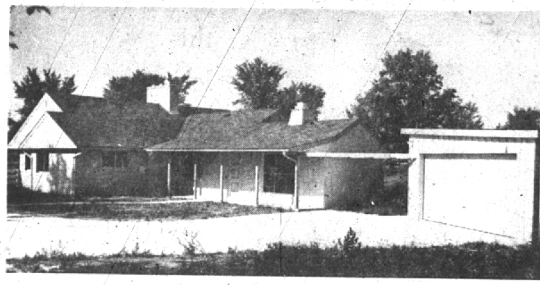
Ribbons Bloom At Flower Show

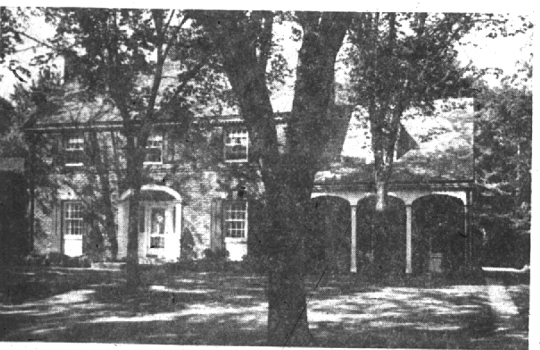

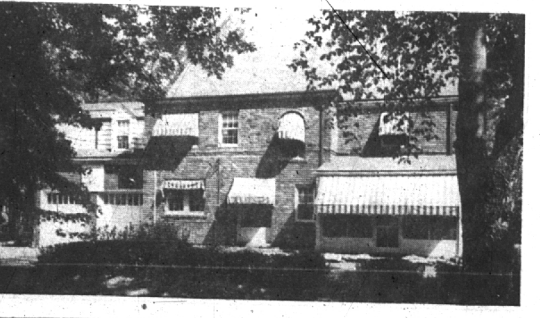

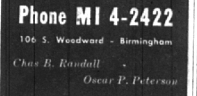
