BIGGEST MUSKIE CAUGHT

Just to prove that all the big ones don't get away, Walter Stanley of 14639 Riverside, Detroit, hooked and landed the year's biggest muskellunge in Michigan virtually within the shadows of the city's skyscrapers. Wait was trolling for walleyes in the Detroit River just before dark on September 9th when it happened. His tackle was conventional for Detroit. River fishermen trolling inboard reel loaded with metal line to take it down in the fast current, terminated with a long stretch of 20 pound test leader.

A small lure known as a "Whinnic" This is kind of a midget propeller, orange colored with black dots, about one inch wide. A treble gang of #6 hooks is attached, and on one of the hooks is a piece of white rubber another inch long cut out to resemble a small minnow.

Walt Stanley had caught one walleye and was on his last swing across the river when the line seemed to rise to the surface slowly. There was no vicious tug as the fish took the lure and began to come to the surface. Stanley struck solidly and thought he had a big walleye. It wasn't until 5 minutes later that the muskie came out of water far behind the boat. To dispel any such belief, and one look at the size of the fish gave Walt the shivers.

You Serve Yourself at New 'Lumberteria'

A million board feet of lumber already had been moved into the Restrict Lumber Co.'s new storage area on Eton road, Company Vice President R. C. Restrict, Jr., disclosed this week.

Two months ago the company began to construct facilities here and to move all bulk lumber storage to Birmingham from the former location at Wyoming and Linden, Detroit.

The company's general office will remain at the Wyoming site, as well as some small amount of lumber to service retail customers, said Restrict, who also is president of the Restrict Quality Millwork Co., which moved to Birmingham about two years ago.

"However, the bulk of our lumber will be sold from the new Birmingham yard," he explained.

ALL NEW lumber shipments are being sent to the local yard, while sales are being supplied from the Wyoming plant until its stock is exhausted, he said.

One of the Birmingham yard's innovations is a "lumberteria," a self-service from which retail customers will be able to pick their own pieces of lumber from bins plainly marked with name, size and per foot price of the lumber, Restrict revealed.

The new Birmingham site contains 250,000 square feet of storage space, and now permits the company to serve customers in all four directions, Restrict said.

"OUR MOVE to Birmingham also recognizes the fast-growing residential and commercial devel-

opment of this north suburban 170' feet of frontage along Eton road. Mechanical equipment is used in this new bulk storage yard has to load and unload the lumber.

A grand opening for the Eton yard is planned for Oct. 8-4. The Restrict Lumber Co. was founded in 1884.

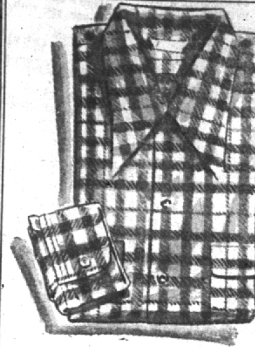
