

Three Killed In Collision

A father and two of his children died Labor Day in a traffic collision on Dequindre between Fifteen and Sixteen Mile roads, Oakland County.

Oscar T. Garner, age 40, 37073 Dequindre, Macomb county, his son, Robert, age 13, and his daughter, Sharon, age 12, were killed when the car Garner was driving was struck in the rear by a car driven by Robert Johnson, age 39, Detroit.

Garner was thrown from the car and killed instantly. The two children burned to death in the back seat when leaking gasoline ignited.

Three other children and their mother were injured in the crash. A daughter, LaDonna, age nine, suffered severe burns about her body, a son, Conan, age 10, suffered an injured leg and burns, and another son, Jerry, was treated and returned for a head cut.

MRS. GARNER, age 40, sustained a fractured shoulder and hip. Her condition was given as "good" by hospital authorities Tuesday.

According to the Oakland County Sheriff's department, the family were on their way to pick beans for the day when Garner turned around to return home for clothes for the children. The collision occurred after the Garner car had made the turn.

Johnson is being held by the Sheriff's department for investigation of negligent homicide. This is the second tragedy involving fire that the Garners have encountered. Last Christmas Eve their home was gutted by a fire and the family has been working on the re-building of the home throughout the summer.
