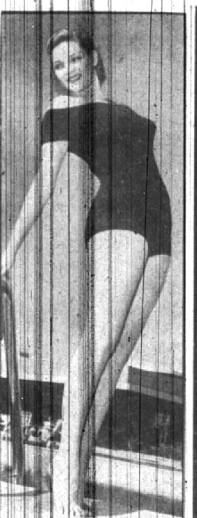
### Canadian Consul Discusses Foreign Trade Policies

Speaking of American aid to foreign countries, Bert Butler, Canadian Consul in Detroit and former Rotarian, told the Birmingham Rotary club Monday, "You don't like it and strangely enough, neither do the recipients. They would rather have trade than aid."

The widely traveled member of the consular service for many years, said Canadian policy almost paralleled that of the United States, loaning funds and personnel for foreign customers "until they got back on their feet."

The average Canadian knows his economy depends on trade with other nations, Butler said. "We've been encouraging these other countries to sell in Canada, so they will have Canadian dollars with which to buy our products."

"We are watching Washington carefully to see what will come out of the American policy, particularly in the field of trade," Butler showed a color film made at the International Trade fair in Toronto last June. It shows Canadian industry from both the manufacturer and consumer angle along with the resources of the country and the effect all have on the life of the average Canadian citizen.
