Drama Aspirants Vie For Will-O-Way Award

A scholarship for the 1953 summer season of the Will-O-Way Apprentice Theater will be awarded for the fourth year by the Michigan State Federation of Women's Clubs.

Applications are now being accepted from women over sixteen years of age by Miss Merrill Thayer, director of the apprentice theater which opens June 29.

PRELIMINARY tryouts will be held until June 6, with final tryouts being held the week of June 8 at Will-O-Way, West Long Lake road, at Telegraph, Bloomfield Hills.

Each applicant must be sponsored by a club which is a member of the federation. Each applicant must send a picture and a letter listing all plays or other dramatic activities in which she has participated. In addition, three character references, three dramatic references and a letter from the sponsoring club are required.

Announcement of the scholarship rules will be made at the Federation's annual meeting to be held this month in East Lansing.

APPLICANTS will be screened by a board of review. The winner will receive complete living accommodations on the Will-O-Way premises in addition to the apprentice theater course work which includes all phases of theatrical production. Apprentices will be awarded certificates at the close of the season, September 7.

SWEET POTATO MOYNDIS WITH SAUSAGE

3 cups corn flakes
2 tablespoons melted butter
2 cups mashed sweet potatoes
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon pepper
1 cup currant jelly
1 pound pork sausage links

Crush corn flakes into fine crumbs. Add melted butter and mix thoroughly. Combine mashed sweet potatoes with seasonings.

Shape into 6 round balls. Roll in corn flakes crumbs. Bake in moderate oven (350°) about 25 minutes.

Make depression on surface of each mound and drop one teaspoon currant jelly on top of each. Serve sweet potato moyndis surrounded by browned sausage links on steamed potato servings.

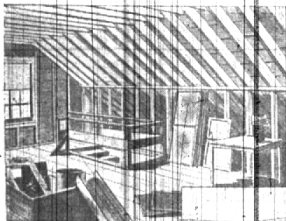

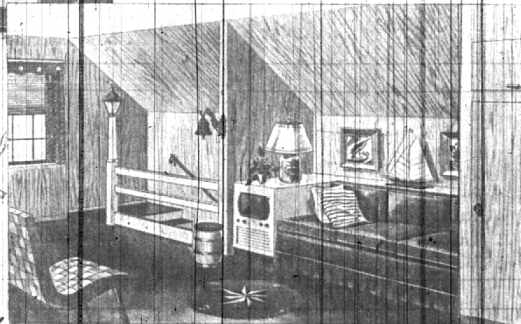

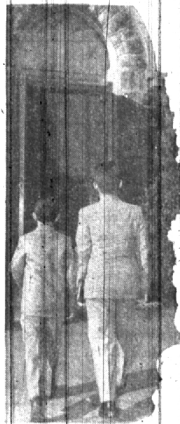
