Players Schedule Hiss-and-Boo Play

Ninety years after its premiere in London, Tom Taylor's "Ticket-of-Leave Man" will reach Birmingham as the closing production of the setting for the Village Players, April 23 through 26.

One of Taylor's later plays, it is regarded as an unusual example of theatrical history. For this reason, the Players will depart from tradition and present four consecutive performances, all open to the public.

The Players production will correspond with the style in which the play was presented by American touring companies in the late years of the last century.

AUDICIENS will be encouraged to hiss the villain and cheer the hero!

The author was an editor of Punch, and a prolific writer of popular plays. His work included "Our American Cousin," the comedy which President Lincoln was drinking when he was assassinated.
