'M' Alumnae Hear Regent

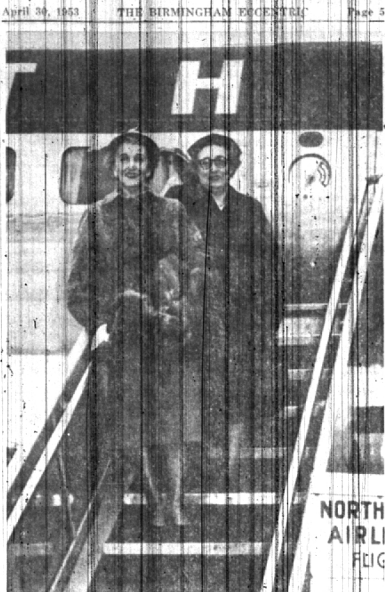
