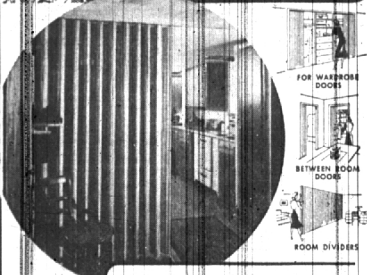

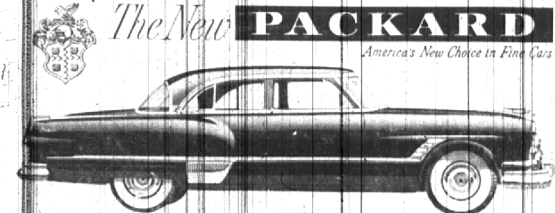

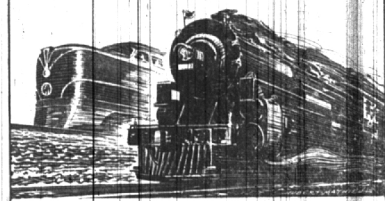

The two-day affair was held for a mutual discussion on such problems as shelter operation, equipment, sanitation, animal care and health, placement, rabies immunization and the maintenance of financial and animal records.

At the same meeting commissioners received a letter from Mrs. Martin A. Wendell, mother of Miss Susan Wendell, victim of the same accident, thanking them and Birmingham city employees for their expressions of sympathy.

City-Due Accounts Become Assessments

Delinquent bills amounting to \$1,316.61, some dating back to 1951, for services performed by the City of Birmingham will be levied against the properties and property owners involved following action of Birmingham city commissioners Monday night.

Special provisions in the city charter allow such delinquent accounts to be levied against the property holder as special assessments.

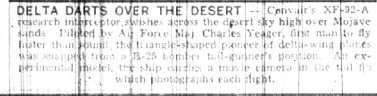
