Flashing Red Lights, Sirens, on Private Cars Rapped by Police Chief

Police Chief Ralph W. Moxley this week warned Birmingham drivers about using red flashing lights and sirens on personal cars.

"We received a complaint concerning one such case last week," Moxley said, "and ordered the light removed."

"The fact that this particular car is used on emergencies does not alter the fact that the flashing light is illegal. Each installation must be approved by the commissioner of state police, and no approvals have been given for this area."

Moxley advised all motorists to remove such lights from their cars or trucks and to refrain from using sirens to clear a right-of-way through traffic.

"The only ones who have permission to do this are fire and police departments and ambulances," Moxley said.
