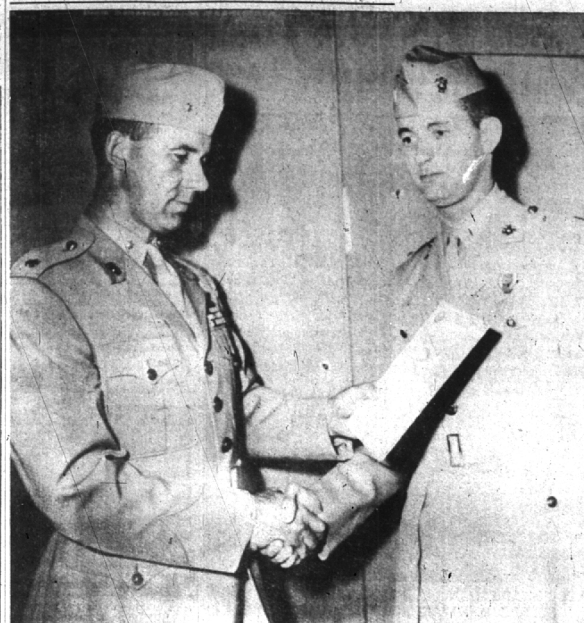

USMC Cites Birmingham Officer

A citation for "excellent service in the line of his profession, has been presented to 1st Lt. Edward S. Reid III, by E. A. Pollock, Maj. Gen., U. S. Marine Corps.

The citation and medal were presented Aug. 30, by Maj. Nicholas Shields from the USMC station in Detroit, who personally commended the lieutenant for his splendid service record.

FOR EXCELLENT service in the line of his profession while serving with a Marine infantry regiment during operations against the

enemy in KOREA from 15 Aug. 52 to 8 Jan. 53. "Serving as a regimental liaison officer, First Lieutenant Reid displayed outstanding ability and professional skill. He worked long hours under adverse conditions and travelled many miles over rugged mountainous terrain in order to transport highly classified documents.

"His knowledge of infantry tactics enabled him to furnish accurate and timely information vital to the formulation and execution of operations against the enemy and advising the regimental commander of the tactical situation prevailing along the entire front.

FIRST LIEUTENANT REID'S selfless devotion to duty served to inspire all who observed him and his conduct throughout was in keeping with the highest traditions of the U. S. Naval service. "Commemoration Ribbon with Combat 'V' authorized.

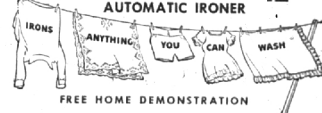
