**Plays for Children
Written by Sisters**

In Birmingham two sisters are taking their places as the community's best known playwrights. Shirley and Louise Hersey of 480 West Maple, began their writing careers while attending Baldwin high school, when they formed the Scribblers' club.

From that point they continued to play and studying settings to assure a feeling of realism for each production.

Many hours are spent on research through historical books and technical sources to further enable them to maintain the authenticity of detail and background.

IN ALBION college they did considerable writing and both have written publicity for area Girl Scout groups. They have also handled publicity for the Sight Conservation and Aid to the Blind groups in the area.

Their career in theatrical writing took its biggest forward step in 1947 when they prepared the script for "The Broken Arrowhead" for the Birmingham Branch of the American Association of University Women.

The play, produced here, was written after lengthy research in the life of Chief Pontiac whose bands rained the area about 150 years ago.

CURRENTLY they are working on the script of "Tants in the Wind," a play of egypty origin.
