BHS Band Alumni Go With MSC to 'Bowl'

Four alumni bandsmen of Birmingham high school will be among the 130 members of the Michigan State college marching band at the Rose Bowl game on New Year's Day. The quartet includes Ronald Phillips, Ronald Nightingale, Glenn Emery and Bill Berndt.

Pete Plumstead, another Birmingham alumnus, will also be at the game as a Michigan State cheerleader although he will not travel with the band.

Sponsored by Oldsmobile Division of General Motors, the band has planned an itinerary that takes in a lot of cities going and coming, stopping for parades and concerts.

A New Year's eve party for the band is planned but, since rising must be at five o'clock in the morning January 1, for final game preparations, the festivities of the party will probably be dampened.

The morning after the Rose Bowl game the band will proceed to San Francisco to participate in a parade and the East-West game. Here the band will be housed in Oakland.
