Files Claim of Appeal On City Court Verdict

City Attorney Forbes S. Haswell said David Pence, Pontiac attorney representing Clare H. Graham of Detroit, has filed a claim of appeal for his client.

Graham, arrested by Birmingham police on Dec. 7, was found guilty of driving under the influence of liquor when he appeared before Birmingham Justice John J. Gaffill on Jan. 2. It was the city's first test case on the use of the intoximeter to determine intoxication.

Gaffill withheld sentence, at the request of Pence, until Jan. 9, when the Pontiac attorney said he would take the case to circuit court. It is scheduled for the February court term.

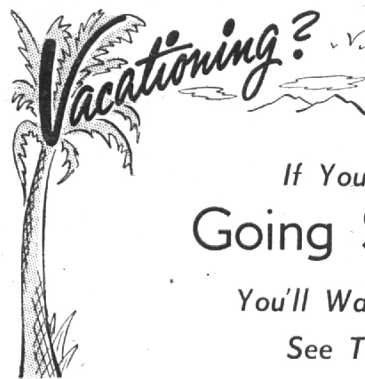
