Birmingham city commissioners Monday night agreed to the city's straightening the east end of Lincoln across from the Elton Park property to add additional property to city-owned lots in the area, preparatory to the proposed sale of the lots.

Both the city plan board and recreation board concurred with City Manager Donald C. Egbert's belief that the land would be of no use as park property and that the most reasonable disposition of the land would be its sale as industrial property.

### Comfort Keynote Of Living Room For Family Use

A living room should be just what the name implies. It should be enjoyed by every member of the family and should present a picture of comfort and friendliness.

A comfortable living room is full of pleasing colors that give a feeling of rest and peace and at the same time are bright and gay. Remember when choosing the colors for a living room that muted colors are probably the best investment because one does not tire of them as quickly as of brilliant colors. Try to picture how the room will look when completely decorated, even to the furnishings. Mixing light and dark woods gives a pleasing impression and fixing modern with Victorian or Sheraton is considered quite good.

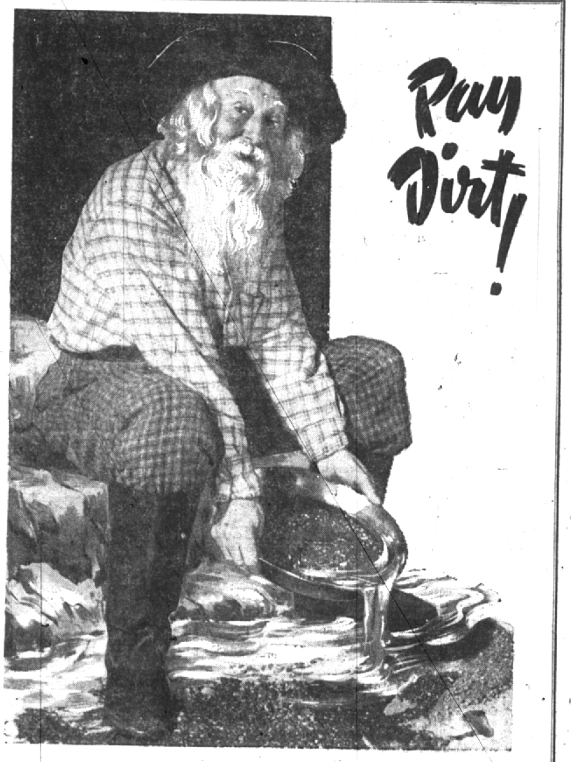
**PORK CHOP—NOODLE CASSEROLE**  
6 pork rib or loin chops, cut 3/4 to 1 inch thick  
2 teaspoons salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
4 cups cooked wide noodles  
1 can tomato soup  
1/2 cup water  
2 tablespoons grated onion  
Brown pork chops slowly. Season with half of the salt and pepper. Place noodles in casserole. Dilute tomato soup with water; add grated onion and remaining seasoning and pour over noodles. Place pork chops on noodles. Cover casserole and bake in a moderate oven (350°F.) for 1 hour. 6 servings.
