Birmingham opens league play Friday night when it plays host to a strong Ferndale team.

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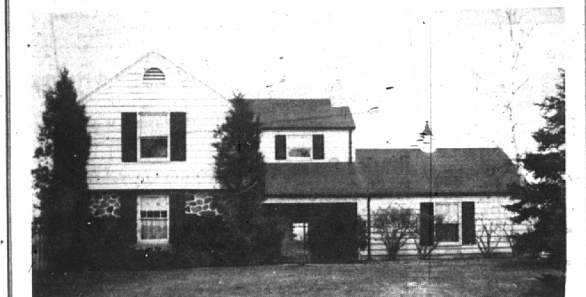

Proper House Numbers Aid To Firemen

Many residences and business places in the City of Birmingham have no street number visible on the front of them. Or in many cases, if the numbers are there they are obscured by shrubbery or they are in a spot too low for quick sighting.

When the fire department is responding to a given street number, on emergency investigations for smoke, defective furnaces, gas investigations or on rescue calls for first aid with the resuscitator or other life saving devices, many valuable minutes are lost as men have to search for the right number.

Where a fire has burned long enough to expose itself and flames and smoke are visible, house numbers are not important. But the majority of the calls answered by the fire department in Birmingham are of the first classification and proper house numbering is all important to the home owner as well as the department.

Be sure that your house numbers, if they are not as described below, are brought up to this standard.

1. USE AT least 3 inch numbers and where room is available use 4 inch.
 2. Use a number in color contrast, such as black with white or white with black. If a home is of brick veneer type, mount the numbers on a small white or black board, that make a neat unit.
 3. Locate the numbers on the house within a foot or two of the upper half of the door opening on the street they are assigned to.
 4. The best and most practical location for house numbers is near a door and where the porch light will illuminate them at night to eliminate the need of searching for them with spot lights. Be sure when you call for emergency service at night, to turn this light on.
 5. If you place your house number on the lawn near shrubbery, duplicate it in the location described above.
 6. If you do not know your proper house number call the building inspector's office. They will tell you your proper number.
- Don't put off correcting a bad set of numbers on your house until next week—that may be too late. **PLAY IT SAFE!** Do it now!

Temporary Walks Approved; Access Drives to Wait

Temporary sidewalks on the north side of Humphrey and Bennett, between the alley and Woodward avenue, are going to be installed by the city.

Birmingham commissioners approved the move Monday night in answer to a petition submitted some months ago by neighborhood residents.

Nonexistence of any hard surface to walk upon has caused residents to wade through the mud during inclement weather, they claimed.

In discussing the temporary walks, several comparatively "new" commissioners suggested that the city start planning the remaining access drives on South Woodward, four blocks of which were installed several years ago.

But the more experienced city officials, like Commissioner Ralph A. Main and City Manager D. C. Egbert, pointed out that when the access drives were first mentioned, merchants in the area vociferously opposed such action by the city.

This bit of information caused the remainder of the commission to suggest "forgetting" the project until more business development took place along that portion of US-10.

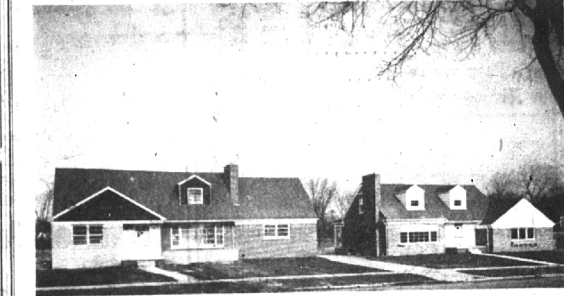
