City Can't Serve Troy Sections, Officials Agree

Sewage disposal problems in Troy township land immediately east of the city continue to plague Birmingham city commissioners. Commissioners, finally agreeing to at least temporarily serve the Arthur Necham property including the site of the proposed Pembroke elementary school with sanitary sewage disposal connections, have now been asked to serve all of sections 29 and 30 that lie within the boundaries of the South Oakland County Sewage Disposal District.

The city, fearful that such a request would jeopardize the agreement already reached to serve the

school board property, instructed City Manager Donald C. Egbert to report to Troy township board members the limitations of the city's services.

IN A LETTER to the commission from Supervisor Norman Barnd, Troy board members asked that the city and township negotiate an agreement for transmission of Troy sewage from the portions of section 29 and 30 not within the city limits.

Egbert reported that to pump the sewage from sections 29 to Birmingham would be impractical from an engineering standpoint because the normal contour of the ground falls to the east.

Egbert also suggested that the sewage problem in that area be considered separately and the proper sewers installed to handle the flow as it normally would be directed.

He requested that Troy be informed of the city's limitations in serving this area outside of Birmingham boundaries. Egbert agreed with Beier and added that the city cannot afford to permit the development of this site across at the city's expense.
