### Eton Triangle Rezoning Up For Decision

Unless Birmingham city commissioners suddenly reverse their stand—and this appears highly unlikely—an 11-acre triangle of property right-of-way north of Maple will be rezoned to multiple dwelling use Monday night.

This July 20 hearing to consider the rezoning stems from a proposed compromise settlement between the city and the Industrial Land Co. and others, which are involved in a circuit court case over how the area shall be zoned.

Discussions between the two parties have resulted in a tentative agreement by the city to rezone the area to multiple, while the Industrial Land Co. would have the court enter a final decree incorporating the actual land development as most recently outlined.

The Pembroke Manor Assn., a defendant along with the city, also has reluctantly agreed to the compromise.

The Birmingham plan board, acting on a routine referral of the matter to it, only last week reaffirmed a July 18, 1952, recommendation that the area be retained in single family use.
