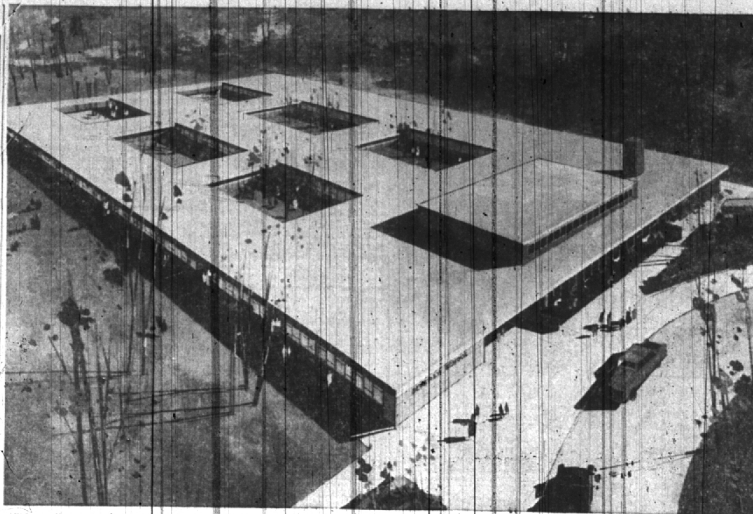

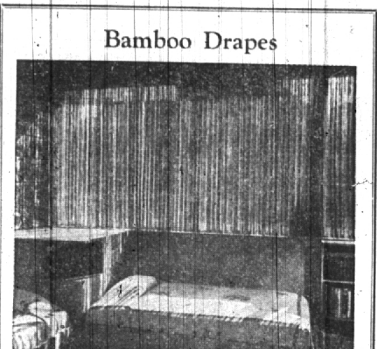

Dr. John Hannah of Michigan State college was one of the staunch backers of the idea that education is the best way of making progress with foreign countries and establish a basis of understanding for all concerned. Through his efforts and the state department, the plan was put into use, with Michigan State selected as the participating college for the pilot program. These young people represent five fields, education, public administration and health, industry and agriculture. Their program in this area was arranged to provide some rest and relaxation from the rigid schedule under which they are operating as they tour the United States.
