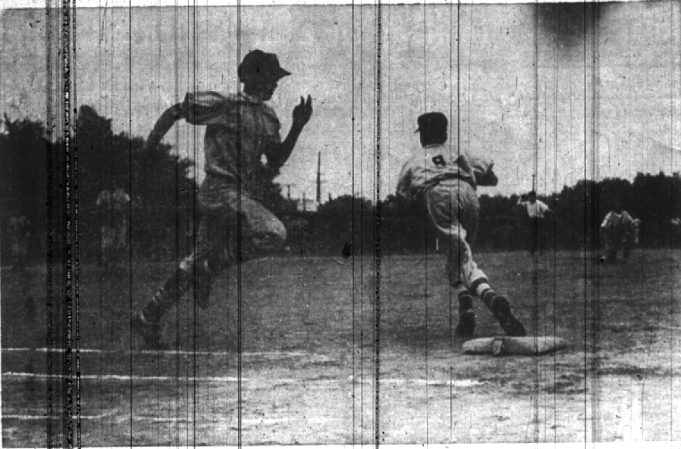


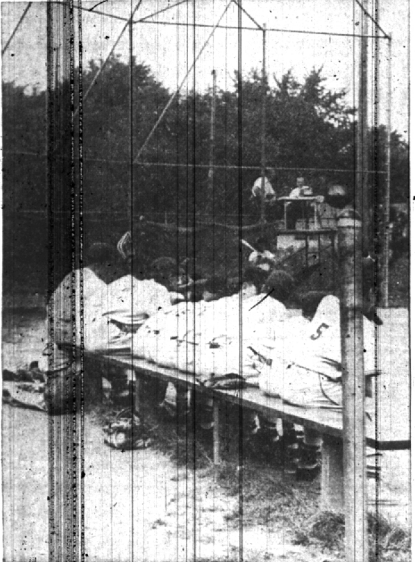
Little League Stars in Action



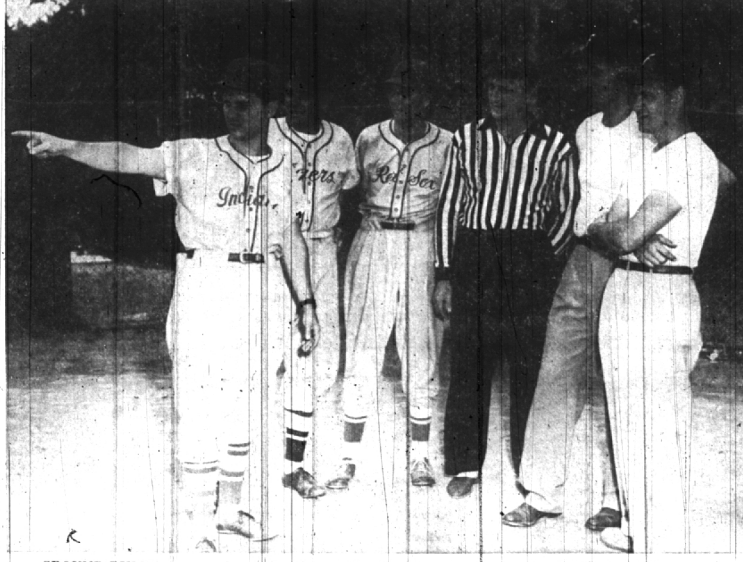
