**SEWER DISPOSAL ORDINANCE**

lation which shall be issued upon payment of a fee of three dollars (\$3.00), which application and permit shall be substantially as follows:  
**SECTION 11. APPLICATION.** When any person or corporation shall have the authority, through the Township Building Inspector of the Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County and State of Michigan, to construct a connection to any sewer line or sewer tanks in any street, alley or highway and shall have authority to install sewer lines after inspection has been made and the work approved, the said tanks shall be stamped as not to be changed, moved or altered, by means of cutting and the gas tanks shall at all times be equipped with vent pipes or vents and lights which will exclude the outside of said sewer, street or highway without danger to life, body or property. The construction of such tanks shall be subject to the approval and inspection of the Township Building Inspector before making any connection to any County Drain Act 216, P.A. 1923.

**SECTION 10. DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE.** The Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan, shall have the authority to construct, maintain and operate sewer tanks and lines which may hereinafter be established, maintained or operated and to provide for the disposal of sewage from buildings used for residential, commercial or industrial purposes and for the construction, maintenance and operation of sewer tanks and lines which may hereinafter be established, maintained or operated.

**SECTION 11. POLLUTION.** It is further provided that no SEWER OR DRAIN other than sewer, cesspool or rain water, shall ever be connected to any sewer, street or highway in the Township of Bloomfield. No drain shall be connected to any sewer, street or highway within the Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan, which will cause the pollution of any water body.

**SECTION 12. ENFORCEMENT.** To enforce the provisions of this ordinance, the Township Building Inspector shall have general supervision and control of inspection, construction, installation, repair, alteration or maintenance of all sewer tanks, lines and dry wells, and shall have authority to enter any building or premises at any reasonable time when it may be necessary for the performance of his duties. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance, shall have power to inspect or condemn any sewer tanks or toilet in the Township of Bloomfield and enforce the provisions of this ordinance relative to the same, shall have power and in his duty to stop work of any sewer tank or toilet thereof which is being constructed, installed, maintained, or altered in violation of this ordinance and any work prohibited by this ordinance until the provisions of this ordinance are complied with. If any order authorized herein is not obeyed, the Building Inspector may apply for a court order of contempt, or for an order of summary judgment to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 13. PENALTY.** ANY PERSON, FIRM or corporation, who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who shall neglect or refuse to comply with any order authorized herein, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and cost of prosecution and when such fine and cost are imposed the court may provide for the forfeiture of the property of the offender or offender's surety to the Township of Bloomfield, Oakland County, Michigan, in 2000th session convened on the 15th day of July, A.D. 1935. **SECTION 14. DESIGN.** The liquid capacity of a septic tank shall be not less than 100 gallons. If garbage disposal is to be connected to the tank, the capacity shall be increased to 150 gallons. **SECTION 15. APPEAL.** Any person aggrieved by the action of the Building Inspector, may appeal to the Township Board, who shall cause a hearing to be held on the date thereof and a decision of said board shall be final.

**SECTION 16. WELLS.** All septic tanks and lines shall be 150 feet from wells. If they are too small for such location, they shall be located hereinafter. The complete title shall be 150 feet from wells. If the well has a diameter of 12 inches, the well must be 150 feet from the septic tank. If the well has a diameter of 18 inches, the well must be 150 feet from the septic tank. If the well has a diameter of 24 inches, the well must be 150 feet from the septic tank. If the well has a diameter of 30 inches, the well must be 150 feet from the septic tank. If the well has a diameter of 36 inches, the well must be 150 feet from the septic tank.

**SECTION 17. TANK AND TILL FIELD.** All tanks and till fields must be at least ten (10) feet from the owner's property line. Provided, however, Building Inspector may grant written permission to erect tank or till closer to the property line.

**SECTION 18. INSPECTIONS.** THE SEWER TANKS and all connections must be left unobstructed and no obstructions shall be placed thereon, either shall the tank be used until the well and materials have been subjected by the Inspector and the Township Building Inspector.

**SECTION 19. PERMIT.** BEFORE PROCEEDING TO CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR or INSTALLATION of any septic tank, the owner or his agent shall apply to the Township Building Inspector for a permit
