**Amendment to Zoning Ordinance
Off-Street Parking**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, July 27, 1953, at 8 o'clock P.M. a public hearing will be held in the Commission Room of the Municipal Building in the City of Birmingham to consider an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 221 of the City of Birmingham, requiring the provision of off-street parking, and establishing a new parking district zoning classification.

Section 12 A as proposed would permit properly developed parking areas adjacent to business and industrial property.

Article 20 as proposed would require that all new business, as well as residence and industry, provide off street parking.

Copies of the amendments as proposed are available from the Planning Director.

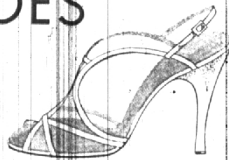
