

**WALNUT ROVAL BARS**

1 cup butter or margarine  
1 cup sugar  
2 eggs  
1 cup enriched flour  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon cinnamon  
1 cup walnut meats, broken coarsely

Cream together butter, sugar and eggs. Add vanilla, sift together flour, salt and cinnamon, then add to creamed mixture blending carefully. Stir in walnut meats. Spread mixture evenly in 8-inch square pan and bake in 350 degree oven for 35 minutes or until done. Let cool slightly before cutting into squares. Remove from pan and roll in powdered sugar.




