Cranbrook Shows Textile Designs

Silked fabrics illustrating the most popular floral motifs throughout history will be shown in an exhibition entitled "The Symbol of the Rose in Textile Design" at Cranbrook Institute of Science daily from 2 to 5 p.m. during the month of June.

These hand-worked textiles, both woven and printed, cover a wide range of period styles, including the rich colors of the Renaissance; the softer tones of the 18th century; and the brilliant hues of the French Empire period. Displayed in five grand lengths, the fabrics are woven in damasks, brocades, lampasses and brocades; and depict the rose theme through its variations in many epochs and nations.

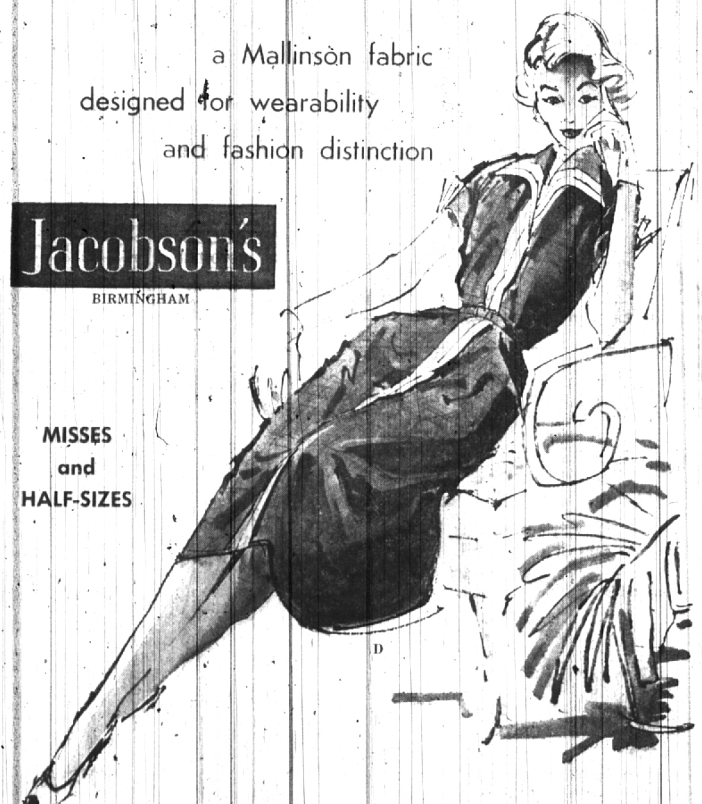
