Ninety Children Participate In Y Overnight Camp

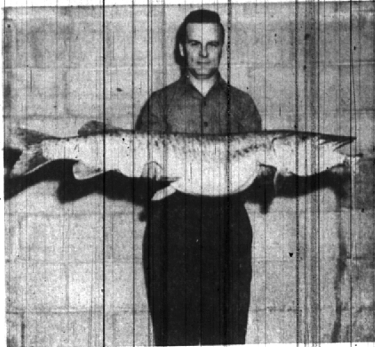
