

**ORDINANCE NO. 129**  
**AN ORDINANCE TO**

**Section 1.** No person shall engage in the business of operating a taxicab upon the streets of the Township of Southfield, Oakland County, Michigan, without having first obtained a license therefor as provided herein. Any person who operates a taxicab without such license shall be liable for the same as provided herein. Any person who operates a taxicab without such license shall be liable for the same as provided herein.

**Section 2.** Application for license for each vehicle under this ordinance shall be made under oath and in writing upon forms to be furnished by the Township Clerk and shall state applicant's full name; whether married or single; age and residence; and the horse power and ownership of engine number and license number of the automobile to be used in said business and its seating capacity and that the applicant is a citizen of the United States and of good moral character and is a resident of the Township of Southfield, Oakland County, Michigan, for at least one year; and that he has not been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude within the last five years; and that he is not a person of poor credit standing. The Township Clerk shall make such investigation as may be necessary in regard to the applicant and shall endorse upon the application his approval or rejection. If such application is rejected, it shall state the reason therefor. If such license shall be issued to any person less than twenty-one years of age, it shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance. If the applicant is a person of good credit standing, the Township of Southfield, or who is not a person of good moral character.

**Section 3.** Upon the approval of any application by the Township Clerk, the Township Clerk shall issue a license to the applicant for a period of one year from the date of issuance. **Section 5.** No license for any vehicle shall be transferred without the prior approval of the Township Board, any attempted or supposed transfer of any such license shall be void, and shall be cause for immediate revocation of the subject license.

**Section 6.** It shall be unlawful for any person to operate, or cause or permit to be operated, any taxicab within the Township of Southfield, unless and until there shall be provided, for each vehicle so operated, liability insurance to protect both the passenger, passengers or property carried by such taxicab and to protect other persons or property who may be injured or damaged by reason of the operation of such taxicab. Such insurance shall provide for the payment to passengers in any taxicab, of not less than \$10,000 for the injury of any one person, or the damage of any one person's property, and not less than \$25,000 for all persons injured or property damaged as the result of an accident, identical minimum limit shall be provided with respect to property or damage sustained by persons or property other than passengers and property transported by such taxicab. Such insurance shall be secured from any insurance company licensed to do business in the State of Michigan, certificate of insurance, or other satisfactory evidence of the issuance of such insurance shall be delivered to the Township Clerk at the time of, or prior to,

**Part I—LICENSING OF DRIVERS:**

**Section 11.** No person, whether or not a citizen of the State of Michigan, shall drive a taxicab except as provided in this ordinance. Any person who drives a taxicab without such license shall be liable for the same as provided herein.

**Section 12.** Any person applying for a taxicab driver's license shall first before the Township Clerk, and shall submit to the Township Clerk an examination before a person designated by the Township Board. The applicant shall be examined on his knowledge of the traffic laws and laws of the State of Michigan, and on his ability to drive a motor vehicle, and in addition, shall furnish a certificate from the Township or Health Officer that he or she is not suffering from any contagious or infectious disease.

**Section 13.** Each application for a taxicab driver's license shall be in writing and filed with the Township Clerk. It shall state the applicant's name, age, residence, and such other information as the Township Board may require. The applicant shall also file with the Township Clerk a photograph of himself, and a true photograph of the vehicle to be operated. The Township Clerk shall endorse upon the application his approval or rejection. If such application is rejected, it shall state the reason therefor. If such license shall be issued to any person less than twenty-one years of age, it shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance. If the applicant is a person of good credit standing, the Township of Southfield, or who is not a person of good moral character.

**Section 22.** It shall be unlawful to use any taxicab upon any street for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers if the side of such taxicab is more than two feet distant from the curb on the right hand side thereof. All applications for such purpose shall be made at such places and in accordance with such regulations as may be prescribed by the Board of Oakland County, Township Police, or the Michigan State Police.
