

### Authority Planned In Fight Against Dutch Elm Disease

The deadly potential of Dutch Elm disease to the elms of Birmingham and surrounding communities has resulted in an effort to establish a several-community authority to coordinate projects to control the disease.

An invitation for Birmingham to send representatives to a meeting for the purpose of organizing such an authority was received by the city commission from the Oak Park city planning commission Monday night.

Commissioners decided to withhold action on supporting the proposed authority pending a report on the disease in Birmingham by

City Forester William Lebold.

LEBOLD TOLD the commission, "We've got to do what we can to control the disease in Birmingham regardless of what our neighbors do. It helps a great deal if everyone cooperates. We kept up with the disease this year, but we expect more next year. Most of next year's cases are expected to occur on private property, and that is where we haven't gotten too much cooperation."

Lebold will report to the commission soon on the progress of the disease in Birmingham with recommendations for a program for its control next summer and in the future.

He also said he will attend the meeting on organizing the proposed authority which will be held in Oak Park's city hall Nov. 10 at 8 p.m.
