Towansite Community

Believed to have been written in 1742 it is regarded as one of the most ambitious of Bach's 190 works of the great master which are still in existence. It contains choral work, chorales, arias and duets. Its main theme, widely used as a hymn, is familiar to many.

SOLO PARTS for the program will be taken by Mary Louise Lingquist and Mary Jane Walker, sopranos; Marion Jewell, alto; Carl Christensen, tenor and Hugo Edberg, bass.

The program will also include choral numbers "O Praise the Name of the Lord" by Tchaikowsky; "The Surrender of the Soul to the Everlasting Love," Peter Cornelius; and several other numbers.

This service of music, Garabrant said, would be open to the public.
