**Inca Civilization Photo Exhibition At Institute**

The mysterious Inca civilization of Peru is the subject of a photographic exhibition prepared by the editors of LIFE magazine on view during the month of October at Cranbrook Institute of Science, open free to the public daily from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Taken by veteran photographer Frank Scherschel, the pictures have been shown at both the Metropolitan Museum of Art and New York's American Museum of Natural History.

After his return from the European war front, photographer Scherschel made a six-months tour of Central and South America, during which he explored the high, cold mountains of Peru recording traces of the Inca civilization which vanished 400 years ago—a civilization which is still to some extent a mystery because the Incas had no form of writing

and did not record dates. Scherschel's striking photographs, in the enlarged dimensions of this exhibition, graphically reveal the greatness of this little-known and mostly unexplored pre-Columbian America.

The pictures were taken for the most part in the Urubamba Valley, heartland of the Inca Empire. They include the massive and mysterious ruins of Fort Sacahuaman, the hillside village of Winay Wayna explored in 1941, Ollantaytambo and Machu Picchu. A number of the panels are devoted to Machu Picchu, one of the most perfectly preserved of the Inca cities.
