**Graduates Tomorrow From Traffic Course**

Graduation certificates will be awarded Oct. 3 to the 24 police officers—including one from Birmingham—attending the three-week "Introduction to Police Traffic Supervision" course at the Traffic Institute of Northwestern University in Evanston, Ill. The Birmingham police officer is Pitman Milton G. Jones. Franklin M. Kream, Traffic Institute director, and Gerald O'Connell, Institute director of training, will present the certificates. The class began Sept. 14. It stresses information needed by police departments to improve their accident prevention and traffic supervision activities. Nearly 1,800 police officers have attended the course in past years. The traffic institute's training program and its related activities, such as research, field service and publications, are supported principally by the Automotive Safety Foundation, Washington, D. C., and the Kemper Foundation for Traffic Safety, Chicago, Ill.
