Winston Allen, 17, of Ferndale is in St. Joseph hospital, Pontiac, suffering from a fractured pelvis and abrasions and lacerations.

Treated for lacerations and bruises and released from the hospital were three Pontiac youths: John T. Upshaw, 18, Robert Rush, 20, and the driver of the car, Willie Jackson, 20.

ACCORDING to police, witnesses said the car was going south at a high rate of speed when it went out of control and skidded across the island on Woodward. The car tore out two trees and rolled over before it came to rest in the northbound lane.

Bloomfield police reported that Jackson was arrested for having no operator's license on his person.

THE SOLUTION to this problem is relatively near, School Supt. Dwight B. Ireland reports in a story on another page in this issue of The Eccentric.

Graves said the school board has not definitely made up its mind on exactly how much of the area, being referred to by most of the parties as "the Adams road triangle," will be needed.

He said he believes it could extend south of Derby road for a block and a half, between Adams and the railroad, an area something over 10 acres.

According to Egbert, Nechman favors annexation of his property to Birmingham as the best means of solving the water and sewer problems.

TROY TOWNSHIP officials, however, are reported to be viewing this possible loss of territory with some apprehension.

Nechman said Monday night he would pay the entire cost of any sewers, streets and water services his property would require.

Meanwhile, neighbors in Birmingham, immediately south of the triangle, are keeping a careful watch on negotiations, which Egbert has been instructed to continue in an attempt to have the problem resolved.

These Birmingham Estates subdivision residents have repeatedly informed city officials that the subdivision vigorously objects to any use of septic tanks on inadequately-sized lots, and to any population increase that would result from the construction of multiple family dwellings rather than single homes.

Nechman said he plans to place a 104-family multiple unit in the northern tip of the triangle, north of Derby road.
